Hergom are a world-wide company with locations in Chile, Portugal and even Mexico City. Between them, they shipped more than 18,000 stoves in 2004!

Wayne was fortunate enough to sample Spanish cuisine while he was there, and discovered that Spanish food is actually prepared more like Mediterranean food than Mexican. He was surprised to see that Spaniards don't start work until 9:00 or 9:30, usually take a big lunch at 1:30 or 2:00 which will involve beer or wine, and will often work late—8:30 is not uncommon. As a result, restaurants don't open until after 8:30, families eat dinner together at 9:30 or later each night, and discos don't open until 1:30.
